Role requirements

The following requirements are essential for the role:

- Good understanding of developing applications using client-side technologies such as HTML5, CSS, JavaScript, and jQuery or other JavaScript frameworks.
- Experience in server side technologies such as PHP or .Net.
- Experience in using database technologies such as MySQL or Microsoft SQL Server.
- Will need to have the ability to work remotely (reliable Internet connection).

Experience using frameworks such as Symfony and developing for mobile and tablet devices would be an advantage but are not essential.

Typical day

A typical day will begin with a morning team meeting where in turn we would share with each other what we worked on the previous day and how projects are progressing.

As a member of the development team you will then focus on any support incidents that you have been assigned, or which are awaiting a response. Support incidents are issues raised by clients in relation to existing applications which we look after. As a web application developer, you will be responsible for investigating and responding to any support incidents that have been assigned to you within the contracted response time.

The rest of the day will normally be focused on project work that has been assigned. You will be responsible for raising any issues that you may encounter on a project, as well as keeping track of your overall progress in relation to the time allocated.

You will be responsible for keeping other members of the team updated on your progress and also for liaising directly with our clients.

We have monthly technical meetings where the development team will get together to discuss any new developments and new technologies which they are aware of. This is also an opportunity for members of the team to show others what they have been working on and to share their experiences.
